## Week 4 Weavies

#### Weave

This week's theme is to "go over and up", where we are adding a new direction to joining our weavies. So far, we have joined weavies to weavies into rows. Now we're starting to add weavies to a row.

The designs for squares and hexagons will be different, so please make sure that you weave the correct weavies for your loom.

#### Weave this:


Week 4	Squares	Hexagons
Background	4	2
CC1	2	2
CC2		1
CC3		1

#### Assemble


You may choose any joining method you like. For the squares, I recommend the double-overcast or mattress stitch. Search in your group or on the Internet for ideas. For the hexagons, I recommend a simple whip stitch. You may also crochet your squares or hexagons together if you wish.

One challenge this week is to get the right colors into the right places, please keep that in mind when you put your weavies together.

Assemble your SQUARES as follows:




Label "Week 4A"
